

Amusement Park Attendant Job Description

- Provide attraction and event information to guests and patrons aimed at enticing customers to games and other entertainment
- Explain the park's regulations, policies, or procedures to guests and patrons
- Responsible for directing patrons to rides, seats, or attractions; and provide assistance to patrons entering or exiting amusement rides, boats, ski lifts, or mounting/ dismounting animals
- Responsible for scheduling the use of recreational facilities such as golf courses, tennis courts, bowling alleys, and softball diamonds
- Ensure effective record of equipment inventory; store and retrieve items; and assemble and disassemble equipment as required
- Maintain the park's account records
- Monitor the park's operational quality or safety
- Monitor the park's activities to ensure adherence to rules and safety procedures, or arrange for the removal of unruly patrons
- Sell tickets and collect fees from guests and patrons
- Stay up to date on relevant park and department information
- Clean the parks' sporting equipment, vehicles, rides, booths, facilities, or grounds
- Responsible for operating machines to clean, smooth, and prepare the ice surfaces of rinks for activities such as skating, hockey, and curling
- Regularly inspect park's equipment to detect wear and damage and perform minor repairs, and adjustments, or perform preventive maintenance tasks such as oiling of parts
- Stay informed of shut-down and emergency evacuation procedures
- Help fasten safety devices for patrons, or offer directions for fastening devices

- Operate, drive, and explain the use of mechanical riding devices or other automatic equipment in amusement parks, carnivals, or recreation areas
- Responsible for the rentals, sales, or issuance of sporting equipment and supplies, including bowling shoes, golf balls, swimming suits, and beach chairs
- Ensure to verify, collect, or punch tickets before admitting patrons and guests to amusement park venues and rides.
