

Assistant Nurse Practitioner Job Description

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Working in testing lung function, respiratory medicine, and assessing lung function
- Doing occupational therapy, and assessing people's need for equipment's and aids
- Work in an operating theatre area, monitoring patients who are recovering from surgery, assisting in surgical procedures and other procedures
- Offering therapeutic, rehabilitative, social and personal care, e.g. management, bowel care, and catheter insertions etc.
- Work on dietetics; encouraging clients to make healthier food choices
- Providing personal, social, therapeutic and rehabilitative care (e.g. bowel care and management, catheter insertions etc.)
- Analyzing samples in a laboratory
- Providing mental health services, rendering support for adults or young people with mental health issues
- Helping people recover in their homes (stroke rehabilitation)
- Radiography; helping to treat a patient's illness or diagnosing them
- Monitor medications and change dressings
- Offer hearing services as a hearing aid dispenser.

Assistant Nurse Practitioner Requirements – Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities

- You have to be working in the NHS; often in a clinical support role such as dietetic assistant, healthcare assistant or maternity support worker
- Possess healthcare experience; trainee assistant practitioners have a healthcare qualification, usually at level 3, such as the CACHE Diploma in Clinical Healthcare Support
- Assistant practitioners need to be caring and kind

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- They must be knowledgeable confident with using lifting equipment
- Assistant nurse practitioners must be willing to be hands-on with patients
- Have an excellent ability at carefully following procedures and instructions
- Must be able to work in a team while using their own initiative
- Should be able to explain procedures to patients without sounding confusing
- Should be methodical, logical, and careful
- Possess excellent communication skills; listening included
- Must have very strong organizational skills.
