CVS Pharmacist Job Description

- Provide consultation to patients on new drug and drug therapy with a focus on the current medical practices and treatment options
- Order and distribute medication through pharmacies
- Make prescription fills and other related medications, including those prescribed by physicians or medical staff
- Prepare, store, and dispense medications according to all local, state, federal and CVS policies and regulations as well as guidelines set forth by the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA)
- Provide consultation to patients on the use and purpose of nonprescription medication
- Make callbacks to clarify or discuss prescriptions
- Authorize return of medication if they have concerns on patient's prescription
- Update Medication Therapy Management (MTM) and conduct related interventions. This include the ability to discuss important information with the patient using an interpreter when necessary
- Ensure the security of prescription drugs, including the proper storage, counting, and dispensing of drugs
- Provide consultation to patients on non-prescription drug therapy and inform them of their responsibilities when taking medication
- Make calls to the doctor's office to clarify or discuss prescriptions
- Verify insurance benefits and answer questions regarding medications
- Answer general questions that might appear on a pharmacy benefit statement.
