

Family and General Practitioner Job Description

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide advice to patients and members of a particular locality on issues related to hygiene and prevention of diseases
- Give explanation on medical processes, prescribed treatment(s), and results to patients
- Plan and carry out health-related programs in health centers and the community at large so as to inform people on issues like prevention of ailments and treatment of injuries
- Collect and keep records of information that have to do with patients, such as medical history and medical results
- Ensure proper monitoring of patients' health condition and their response to treatment
- Refer patients to specialists in the case of severe or acute ailments to help in treating them
- Coordinate work with nurses, pharmacists, psychologists and other health care providers
- Assist in the delivery of babies
- Carry out surgery on patients to repair and improve the functioning of injured body parts of patients.

Family and General Practitioner Requirements – Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities

- Must possess good communication skill. This is necessary so that the doctor can fully and clearly understand the condition of his/her patient
- Must be able to work with little or no supervision at all times
- Must be able to show understanding and patience while dealing with patients
- Possess excellent interpersonal skills. That is to say that the family physician must be easily approachable and friendly at all times

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- Must have excellent decision-making and problem-solving abilities
- Must have good coordination and organizational abilities
- Good time management skills are a must have
- Good reasoning ability is also required
- Must be someone that pays attention to details at all times
- Possess the ability to work long hours
- A degree in medicine is a basic prerequisite
- Must have completed family medicine internship and residency
- Must possess all the necessary medical licenses and certification needed to work in a particular locality.
- A minimum of 5 years work experience as a general practitioner.
