General Construction Laborer Job Description

- Repair damaged building structures
- Operate heavy equipment
- Clear blocked storm drains, repair leaky pipes, and remove ice from hoses.
- Repair or replace damaged pavement or sidewalks
- Install fences, signs, and other structures on public property
- Construct barricades to prevent traffic accidents at construction sites
- Clean and maintain grounds to support construction activities
- Dispose of debris and garbage at construction sites
- Detain persons for questioning about public safety issues or disposing of dangerous objects
- Inspect construction sites for damage and water leaks, and report them to off-duty supervisors via telephone or portable radio immediately upon arrival on the property
- Give necessary direction to prevent or stop unsafe conditions or conditions that could cause injury, damage equipment, injure workers or cause property damage
- Provide other related services as required by job assignment under the general supervision of a foreman/supervisor
- Guide and counsel supervisors and workers on safety procedures, worksite hazards and other matters as required
- Operate and maintain equipment in a safe manner to prevent injury to employees, guests, and members of the public
- Maintain proper records of work at all times
- Keep off-duty supervisors informed of your whereabouts at all times during working hours; report your absence to the supervisor immediately upon their return.
