Interaction Designer Job Description

- Designs an interface for a software application that makes it easy for users to perform specific tasks. For example, an interface designer might create a user's shopping cart, build a product review section, or develop an interactive security system
- Creates user interfaces for online advertising websites that sell products or services online, such as eBay and Amazon
- Designs the user interface component and technical requirements for websites and programs. For example, a website designer might create the logo design of the product shipping company or monitor client feedback and provide technical support to clients
- Develops software, such as apps for Windows 8.1 or Widows 8 that are interactive and involve the use of touch screen technology
- Designs software (programs), including promotion strategies to increase usage of the program or website by consumers
- Maintains a portfolio that displays the designer's work and abilities
- Designs and develops apps for smart phones, tablets, and computers, such as laptops
- Examines websites created by others for usability and provides feedback on possible modifications to improve their design
- Creates prototypes of different apps and programs that users can test out early on in the development process to get user feedback before going live with the product.
