Landscaper Job Description

- Works in collaboration with architects and garden designers to ensure clients' expectations are met
- Gives valuable advice to clients on how to maintain landscapes
- Acts as a supervisor in maintaining landscape structures, outdoor furniture, and walkways, and in repairing landscapes
- Disinfects the whole landscape with insecticides and other necessary chemicals to ensure it is safe for the client and their visitors
- Carries out general routine maintenance of landscapes
- Ensures the growth of flowers and other ornamental plants through the use of fertilizer and plant friendly chemicals
- Maintains the landscape design and structures in it
- Trims overgrown plants, flowers, and hedges
- Plants new decorative flowers bushes, plants, and shrubs
- Removes weeds and dead plants in the landscape
- Decorates gardens or landscape with stones and plants
- Removes strange bodies like used cans from the garden or landscape
- Maintains already existing irrigation systems, ensures that the flowers and plants are watered adequately
- Advises clients on selection of plants and how they could fit in the landscape
- Removes snows from sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots with the use of shovel or any other tool of choice
- Mark boundaries using good designs and paints in artificial turfs
- Make use of tools such as shovel, rakes, pruning saws, hedge and brush hammers to maintain the integrity of the landscape.
