Production Line Worker Job Description

- Keeps production area clean, sanitized, and free of debris
- Washes glassware and other materials as needed
- Keeps sufficient stock of glassware to meet production demands
- Removes used glassware from sterilizing baths, washers, and other equipment in a timely manner to prevent contamination of glassware and other materials while they are being sterilized, washed or dried
- Observes gauges or meters to determine when washers are full; unloads sterilizers, washers and dryers when they are full by opening drain valves
- Observes gauges or meters to determine when sterilizers, washers and dryers are full; unloads sterilizers, washers and dryers when they are full by opening discharge valves
- Observes gauges or meters to determine when sterilizers, washers and dryers are full; unloads sterilizers, washers and dryers when they are full by turning off heaters, filters, water circuits, or other equipment that is needed for processing of items
- Cleans floors of production lines and wash stations as needed; cleans walls, equipment housing areas and work areas with detergents after disinfections and decontaminations have been completed.
