- Use relevant quality tools and make sure managers and other staff understand how to improve the business
- Make sure the company is working as effective as possible to keep up with competitors
- Specify quality requirements of raw materials with suppliers
- Work with operating staff to establish procedures, standards, and systems
- Always direct objectives to maximize profitability
- Provide support for released products, evaluate product field performance and reliability and recommend corrective and preventive actions
- Manage the selection and development of people, resources, and budgets necessary to perform the functions of the department.
