Resident Aide Job Description

- Offers safety and security
- Provides a sense of continuity
- Initiates contact with other professionals and the community
- Collaborates in the development of resident plans
- Reaffirms residents' identity and encourages participation in activities and decision making, regardless of ability to do so
- Helps residents keep appointments and remain informed of opportunities to participate in care planning
- Provides supplies, equipment, and domestic services needed by the resident or occupant
- Provides transportation for residents when needed
- Assists with personal hygiene and other needs
- Provides appropriate support for promoting the physical, mental, social, and spiritual well-being of the resident or occupant; engages in activities to enhance such well-being
- Provides social support and education to the family whenever requested
- Provides housekeeping services when needed
- Ensures that programs and services are delivered in a manner consistent with the values and philosophy of the organization
- Helps residents maintain contact with friends and family; provides assistance as needed to maintain such contact
- Provides information and referral services to residents and families when requested
- Follows up on resident or occupant's needs or problems with appropriate staff, including physicians, nurses, therapists, counselors, social workers, chaplains.
