Secret Service Special Agent Job Description

- Protecting government and important national figures such as the
 President, Vice President, former presidents, as well as their families
- Frequently traveling to a variety of duty stations as assigned by the United States Secret Service
- Investigating the violation of laws that are related to financial crimes such as credit card and access device fraud
- Thoroughly investigating computer hacking attempts that have occurred on national telecommunication devices as well as banking infrastructure
- Guarding buildings and/or acting as security at events that demand a national level of protection
- Performing undercover work when required
- Complying strictly with the United States Secret Service regulations, guidelines, and/or policies
- Writing reports that are related to investigations and/or protection services and delivering them to the necessary personnel.
