UPS Supervisor Job Description

- Ensure that the entire UPS operation in a plant complies with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations
- Monitor customer complaints and resolve customer problems or disputes without committing a violation of state or federal laws for goods delivery (other than by a requirement of good manners)
- Ensure that the operation of the UPS System meets proper safety standards, including use of proper identification tags, accountability for package contents, accountable for reliability and security of transactions
- Provide appropriate training to employees designated as "UPS Supervisors" in regard to their specific job duties and responsibilities
- Ensure that all state, federal, and company rules are enforced with fidelity to its mission statement, including the HR Policy Manual"
- Assign duties and responsibilities to other employees and monitor their performance
- Maintain automobile with all required accessories, including wipers, lamps, horns, fuses, oil, and gas
- Supervise the operation of UPS System in his/her area of responsibility by administering policies, rules, regulations and procedures that has been established by the company
- Maintain vehicle logs, including entries on gasoline purchased out-ofroute and miles driven for the purpose of showing compliance with state, federal, and company regulations on the use of automobiles for business purposes
- Provide daily reports on the activities of all terminal operations in accordance with company policy
- Comply with personal appearance standards established by the company, including wearing of UPS uniform, grooming, and safety shoes

Maintain proper control over all supplies, including linens, tools, and equipment, and secure them from loss or misappropriation when not actually in use.
