Duties and Responsibilities:

Uber Eats Driver Requirements - Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities

- **Job Experience:** The Uber Eats driver mostly requires no prior experience to be accepted into the program, making it an open entry point for a lot of individuals seeking flexible work. However, there is need to work towards developing experience.
- Technical Skills: Uber Eats drivers need to know how to utilize both new and existing technologies, such as computer billing systems to optimize their work experience.
