

Ultrasound Technician Job Description

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Position patients on examining tables and provide adequate protection based on already existing safety standards
- Perform calibration and adjustment of ultrasound devices in an appropriate manner
- Perform general/routine maintenance of ultrasound machines
- Keep record of images captured during ultrasound process
- Communicate effectively with patients during ultrasound processes.

Ultrasound Technician Requirements – Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities

- Must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills on all fronts
- Must be someone that pays keen attention to details at all times
- Must display a high level of flexibility in the process of carrying out duties. This may entail filling in for other colleagues in the face of tight schedules
- Must be willing and able to work as part of a team, usually under the guidance/supervision of a senior medical staff
- Must be able to work under little or no supervision
- Should be able to multi-task and also have excellent hand-eye coordination
- Must have an in-depth knowledge of human anatomy
- Must have a clear understanding of how to handle ultrasound and or sonography equipment
- A minimum of Associate or Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field
- Nothing less than 3 years of work experience as an ultrasound technician in a health facility
- Must have the necessary licenses and certifications to operate within a given area.
